Shoot, 2 handed turning targets; Run 1000m; Swim 2 mins;

Cross country ride height 75cm approx.

Cross country ride height 85cm approx.

6. Guns: All guns are to be kept in a locked car boot other than at the shooting centre at

time of shoot. Guns must remain boxed until the range steward gives the order

to 'unbox' at the start of the detail and must be boxed again before the

competitor leaves the firing point.

7. Dogs: Please **<u>DO NOT</u>** bring dogs onto the Estate.

8. Legal liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever.
